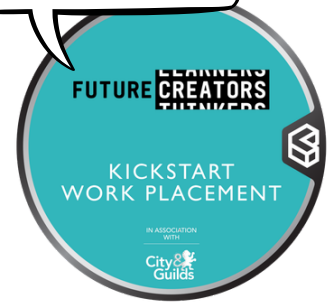


Is Digital Badging valuable when working with young people?

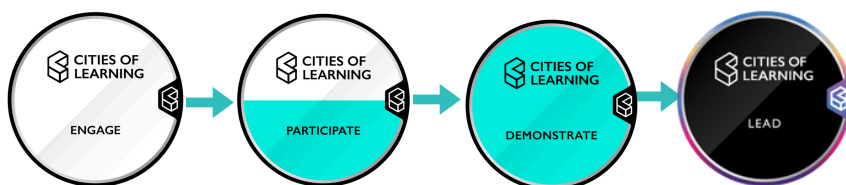
How they work

- Digital badges display the awarding organisation's logo and the specific criteria achieved.
- They acknowledge the development of transferable skills and aptitudes that employers highly value, often not recognised through formal qualifications.
- They serve as a motivating force for learners, recognising their hard work and accomplishments.
- They help earners better showcase their journey of participation with any organisation.

Why they matter

Especially for young people

- Recognize Non-Accredited Learning: A great way to showcase skills that aren't covered by traditional qualifications.
- Motivate and Inspire: Digital badges celebrate hard work, commitment, and accomplishment.
- Gives individuals the proof and specific language to articulate experiences when seeking future opportunities



Badges are rewarded via a weblink. Individuals then get access to their digital certificate. They then can also be displayed directly on LinkedIn, CV or Portfolio.

Organisations can write a badge about anything, and award it to anyone that has achieved the specified criteria. There are also four different designs depending on level of work/engagement of the which are effective at plotting the journey of the receiver.
