We Wunt Be Druv explored...

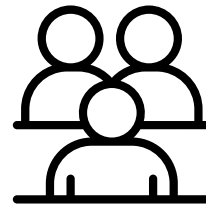
- Planning and delivering creative workshops

- Selling and presenting creative work



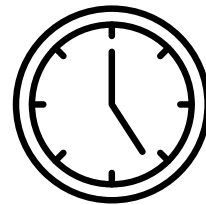
OUTCOMES AND IMPACT

WAYS TO USE THIS CASE STUDY

You could alter this case study to make it work for you:

- Run a youth-focussed art fayre with free workshops in a different location or over a different length of time (e.g. one day, weekly or monthly basis, etc)
- Offer the workshops and art fayre as separate events
- Try and engage more young people in attending the event, not just running it
- Lead the fayre or workshops as part of another large-scale event similar to Artwave, or turn this opportunity into it's own large-scale event
